# Ikebukuro

People of different generations mingle, as amusement and cultures meet here.

The Toden Arakawa Line is the only streetcar remaining in Tokyo, as its route goes through streets with a distinctive atmosphere. In front of the West Exit of Ikebukuro Sta. is the Tokyo Metropolitan Art Space, the center of culture. On the East side, the outstanding 60-storey building is part of Sunshine City, where you can find many must-see spots including “experience attractions,” NAMCO NAMJA TOWN with its food theme park, the Sunshine International Aquarium, and the Ancient Orient Museum.

## C-2 Jiyugakuen Myonichikan 自由学園 明日館



This construction is designated an Important Cultural Property. Frank Lloyd Wright who designed the Imperial Hotel sympathized with the educational philosophy of Jiyugakuen and accepted to work on this building in the Taisho era.

## D-3 Zohshigaya Kishimojindo 雑司ヶ谷鬼子母神堂



The Goddess Kishimojin is said to bring luck in fertility and child bearing. The gingko trees on the premises have been designated a Natural Monument by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government.
